### Position Summary:

Safely operates equipment for Grain Drying and Storage operations performed at Wolf River Grain. Learns, understands and complies with plant safety, grain dryer, storage and production rules and regulations. Monitors, documents, and troubleshoots activities according to established procedures. Keeps others informed of problems or potential problems as indicated.

### Specific Job Duties:

- Operate powered industrial equipment:
  - Payloader to load trucks (for 2-7 hours per day)
  - Skid steer (short jobs)
  - Semi truck in the yard
  - Trackmobile
  - Lawnmower
    - Lawn is rough in places
    - Someone uses lawnmower 12+ hours per week
- Load trucks
  - Involves climbing 10' up stairs or ladder and manually turning a 18" wheel at waist/chest height. (some twisting to open wheel)
- Unload trucks
  - Majority are hopper bottom style trucks.
  - Opening doors requires a range of physical exertion. Most of work is at waist to knee height
- Ground pile pick up
  - Shoveling corn along ground piles walls. Involves bending over.
  - Removing tarp
    - Taking the tarp off includes walking in the corn and on the tarp
    - Pulling tarp off is like pulling a sled in snow

- In and out of truck/pay loader/skid steer
- House keeping
  - Basic sweeping with 24” push broom and shoveling up corn/beans
  - Sweeping with hand brooms
  - Carrying buckets of dust/corn
  - Pushing water with squeegee
- Non Routine and/or Maintenance tasks
  - Lifting parts/tools
    - up to 50 pounds anything over that requires a two-man lift
    - from the ground, waist height or over head

Required Skills & Abilities:

- Work performed is expected to meet or exceed guidelines for safety, quality, accuracy, timeliness and thoroughness.
- Due to 24/7/365 operations and number of operators on each shift, must be reliable and timely in reporting to work.
- Communicate effectively and develop good working relationships with others
- Conduct self with honesty and integrity
- Take initiative to notice what needs to be done and the good judgment to act appropriately.
- Must be able to work both independently and as a team member, and multi-task effectively.
